Dear Exhibitor:

The 11th International Congress on Membranes and Membrane Processes, **ICOM 2017**, will be held July 29 through August 4, 2017 at the Hilton San Francisco Union Square in San Francisco, CA. ICOM is the triennial meeting of the European Membrane Society, Aseanian Membrane Society, and the North American Membrane Society. It is the preeminent global event for the membrane science and engineering community. ICOM 2017 will focus on “Enabling Membrane Technology” to overcome the challenges to replacing conventional technology in separations and energy production.

The Hilton San Francisco Union Square is located in the heart of San Francisco within walking distance of many San Francisco tourist destinations including, for the most adventurous, the Golden Gate Bridge. Convenient access to the hotel from the San Francisco airport is provided by the Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) system. The hotel lies four blocks from the Powell Street BART Station.

The **ICOM 2017** technical program will focus on state-of-the-art topics in membrane science and engineering and highlight innovations that enable successful commercialization of membrane technology. Our all-star plenary lineup features Professor Bill Koros of Georgia Tech University, Professor Andrew Livingston of Imperial College London, and Professor Juin-Yih Lai of Chung Yuan Christian University. The cost of becoming an exhibitor at **ICOM 2017** is \$1,500 USD. For this fee, the exhibitor will receive and be bound by the following terms:

- Use of a display table measuring 30 inches by 6 feet. Free Wi-Fi access. Please contact us if additional space is desired for applicable exhibitor rates.
- Access to an electrical outlet; however, this is not meant to support live demonstrations of systems.
- A listing in the program book.
- Additional space for advertising in the program book is available for an additional fee under our sponsorship program.
- Set up and removal times will be provided at a later date. At no time is NAMS responsible for any equipment or materials brought to the meeting site by the exhibitor.
- Exhibitors must register as Regular attendees for the meeting to attend technical sessions. Exhibitors who wish to participate in the social program only must register as Guests. Exhibitors may bring additional personnel who work only the table if desired at no cost.

Exhibitors may opt for two display tables for \$2,000 USD.
